



Lady Cove Women's Choir Presents: *We Got the Beat!*

St. John's, NL, Friday, October 3: Members of Lady Cove Women's Choir will soon sing together in concert for the first time since their award-winning performances at the World Choir Games in Riga Latvia, where the group took home two gold medals in July.

On **Sunday, October 19th**, the choir will be breaking out of the box, with dynamic music inspired by contemporary, folk, and pop music, that will include the addition of a brass quintet, body percussion, hand bells, djembe, gong and even **beat boxing**.

The women will also be performing a vibrant number from their 3rd place ranking set at the World Choir Games. Aptly titled *Otherworldly Games*, this Ukrainian piece is one of the most challenging works that the choir has ever attempted.

The concert takes place **3:00 p.m., October 19th at Cochrane Street United Church**. Tickets are \$24 for adults, \$20 for students and seniors (plus a box office surcharge). They're available at the Holy Heart Theatre Box Office.

Lady Cove Women's Choir is named after the community of Lady Cove in Trinity Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador. Based in St. John's, the choir of over 40 voices was established by Kellie Walsh in September 2003. After winning first place in the 2008 CBC Radio Competition for Amateur Choirs in the Contemporary Music category, the group took first place at the 2008 Bela Bartok New Music Competition in Debrecen, Hungary. Lady Cove celebrated their 10th anniversary two seasons ago and released their second recording, *Heart's Delight*.
